

#### About Ricker Choi -

Ricker Choi has a successful career in financial risk management but his first love is classical music. Ricker began studying piano at age 13, after his family immigrated to Canada from Hong Kong. After earning the ARCT Diploma in Piano Performance at age 18, Ricker enrolled in York University's Schulich School of Business, where he earned an undergraduate degree and MBA. (He also holds Chartered Financial Analyst and Financial Risk Manager designations.)

After a 12-year hiatus Ricker returned to piano studies with pianist Boris Zarankin in 2005, while continuing his career in financial risk management. Soon after he also started studying with pianists Michael Esch, Lawrence Pitchko, Michael Berkovsky and Kui Min. Ricker has been featured at <u>TSMAF</u>'s Emerging Artists in Concert at Walter Hall, and with <u>Off Centre Music Salon</u> at Glenn Gould Studio many times. In 2011, he gave a solo recital at <u>Four Seasons Centre</u>. His most memorable performances were at the Berlin Philharmonie's 2500 seat Großer Saal and at Paris' 1000 seat Salle Gaveau.

In 2006 Ricker combined his love of piano and philanthropy to establish **Music Heals!**, a series of fund-raising concerts for charity organizations such as SickKids Foundation. Visit **www.rickerchoi.com** for more information.
